- I. Bidder acknowledges that it is the Bidder's responsibility to ascertain whether any Addenda have been issued and if so, to obtain copies of such Addenda. Bidder therefore agrees to be bound by all Addenda that have been issued for this bid.

II. CLARIFICATIONS

A. PRE-BID QUESTIONS – Questions received from bidders and responses are as follows:

1. Q. Do each of the two designated biologists need to have experience in at least two species? Or do the two designated biologists combined need to meet experience in at least two species?
 - A. It is not required but it is preferred that each proposed Designated Biologist has experience with at least two of the listed species. You may propose two Designated Biologists that have a combined experience with at least two species, but this is not preferred.
2. Q. Can additional biologists/monitors meet the species qualifications? (as additional staff)
 - A. Yes as long as the proposed Designated Biologists meet the minimum qualifications.
3. Q. On page 3, the RFQ requests that each candidate firm be required to show evidence of equal employment opportunity? Do we need to include a statement in the response or this is not required?
 - A. Proof is not required. A statement confirming that your company meets that requirement is sufficient. However, proof may be required at a later date if University deems it necessary.
2. Q. On page 10, the Request for Supplemental Information, requests to list each pending litigation. Can you specify what is included in this list?
 - A. Please include the information requested in each section of the form.

III. BIDDING/CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

1. In the cover letter, please INCLUDE a statement about availability for proposed designated biologists and location of home office for the proposed staff including Designated Biologist.
