II. <u>CLARIFICATIONS</u>

- A. PRE-BID QUESTIONS Questions received from bidders and responses are as follows:
 - 1. Q. In the pre-bid meeting it was stated that the SWPPP permit was going to be prepared by University. I would like to verify that and request detailed information about what requirements are going to be necessary for this project. Every project is different regarding SWPPP and I would like to be able to calculate the total possible costs involved with the plan.
 - A. University will issue SWPPP plan in Addendum 2, University will also make the permit application.
 - 2. Q. It appeared that there was some existing fence and possibly some existing irrigation pipe that might need to demolished. Can the owner verify what will be demolished in this contract?
 - A. University will issue a final response in Addendum 2.
 - 3. Q. What staking will be done by the owner? The data files from the designer might not correlate with construction files and I would typically see some sort of initial layout for pond parameter and spillway. Will this be provided?
 - A. Contractor shall have GPS equipped construction vehicles with no need for staking. VNLC monitors will likely do some ground marking with non-toxic spray paint or pin flags. University to provide electronic data files to the contractor for this use. File can be downloaded from the University's Sharefile site. Access to the site will be provided to the Contractor.
 - 4. Q. Where is the project staging area? Will we be required to mobilize our equipment to that staging area every night, or can we leave some equipment within the project work area as long as we are servicing with appropriate safety equipment and spill prevention kits?
 - A. Staging area to be defined in SWPPP drawings which will be issued in Addendum 2.

- 5. Q. Where is the water source going to be for the project? What is the timing for procuring this water source?
 - A. Contractor to assume no water source onsite. Contractor to provide water as needed for the work.
