GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

The Site Development and Infrastructure Project will provide underground utilities, roadway improvements, a corporation yard, and improvements to the Telecommunications Building, Classroom and Office Building and Central Plant including hydronic heating, chilled and R/O water systems.

Determination of Prequalification

The Prequalification Questionnaire and associated documents is due on **April 19, 2012 at 4 PM**. Any person or entity not satisfied with the outcome of the prequalification must file a writ challenging the outcome within 10 calendar days from the date of the University's written notice regarding prequalification determination. Any assertion that the outcome of the prequalification process was improper will not be grounds for a bid protest. However, the University reserves the right to accept late submissions and to request, receive, and evaluate supplemental information after the above time and date at its sole determination. The University reserves the right to reject any or all responses to Prequalification Questionnaires and to waive

non-material irregularities in any response received. **The dates, times, and location set for receiving and opening of bids will be set forth in an Advertisement for Bids.**

All information submitted for prequalification evaluation will be considered official information acquired in confidence, and the University will maintain its confidentiality to the extent permitted by law.
