The Merced campus of the University of California requests that a qualified civil engineering and surveying firm with experience in field topographic land surveying and subsurface utility engineering submit written statements of qualifications for Professional Civil Engineering & Land Surveying Services.

SERVICES DESCRIPTON

The UC Merced campus is committed to accurately determining the terrestrial positions of the existing and proposed physical assets located on the UC Merced Campus and associated University Community. In support of this commitment, the scope of the services will include the ongoing and as needed surveying and corresponding drafting of existing utilities, buildings, landscape, etc.

The University of California is an Equal Opportunity Employer. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Professional Civil Engineering & Land Surveying Services include performing field topographic land survey and subsurface utility engineering on existing and proposed campus buildings and infrastructure utilities.

The University is seeking to contract with a civil engineering and land surveying firm to perform Campus Surveying and Utility Engineering Services for a period of three (3) years. Additionally, surveying work on the campus' existing physical assets is also included as part of this scope. Program level surveying services include the design and development of a survey control network and associated monuments in addition to identify subsurface utilities and other civil engineering that supports

The Civil Engineer will be the lead consultant. The proposing Civil Engineering firm must identify the consulting Land Surveyor and their requisite qualifications for full consideration.

Qualifications of the Civil Engineer Professional

The University is seeking Civil Engineer and sub consultant team(s) with the following experience and qualifications:

- A minimum of ten (10) years experience in civil engineering, utility engineering, and land surveyor services, with experience managing the timely and successful completion of utility infrastructure maps within established and proposed urban environments
- Registered as a Professional Civil Engineer by the State of California
- The capability to provide the services sought by UC Merced and to respond quickly to service requests.
- Agreement to assign capable personnel to this project.
- Have a proven track record of successfully completing this type of work.
- Demonstrated excellence in adhering to tight project budgets and schedules from design through post construction.
- Experience working with multiple stakeholders in a single project.
- Experience with University of California projects is desirable.

Qualifications of the Land Survey Professional

Registration as a Professional Land Surveyor by the State of California

 A minimum of ten (10) years experience in land surveyor services, with experience managing the timely and successful completion of utility surveys within established and proposed urban environments.

• Experience in maintaining and creating a benchmarking/monument system within an urban environment.

Experience performing GPS Surveys, capturing data for GIS Maps.

The Civil Engineer and Land Surveyor should propose the entire team it would use for surveying services. The University will approve or reject the sub consultants. While the University does not expect the need for a mechanical & electrical engineering services, potential sub-consultants are to be submitted for review.

JOINT VENTURES/ASSOCIATIONS

By campus policy, proposals for joint or associated ventures will not be considered for this project. If two firms wish to combine in a project team, one firm must be proposed as a sub-consultant to the other.

INSURANCE

The University requires evidence of insurance coverage, to be presented only after the successful firm is selected to provide services. Submittal of insurance information is not required as part of the Statement of Qualifications.

General Liability, Professional Liability Insurance, Business Automobile Liability, and Worker's Compensation will be required in the following amounts:

If the above insurance is written on a claims-made form, it shall continue for three (3) years following termination of this Agreement. The insurance shall have a retroactive date of placement prior to or coinciding with the effective date of this Agreement.

- 2.Business Automobile Liability Insurance for owned, scheduled, non-owned or hired automobiles with a combined single limit not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence.
- 3. Worker's Compensation as required by California State law.

4. Professional Liability Insurance

If the above insurance is written on a claims-made form, it shall continue for three (3) years following termination of this Agreement. The insurance shall have a retroactive date of placement prior to or coinciding with the effective date of this Agreement.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The University is seeking a creative and technically experienced civil engineering and land surveying team. Candidates should be prepared to demonstrate how their work on other projects has resulted in cost-effective, yet reliable survey data. The Screening and Selection Committees will be interested in teams that:

- Have demonstrated firm and consultant team experience in land surveying services, with experience managing the timely and successful completion of land surveys within established and proposed urban environments.
- Have demonstrated firm and consultant team experience in identifying and documenting reliable underground utility information.
- Have proven firm and consultant team capability to provide creative, functional, flexible, and technologically sound land survey solutions with an economy of means and within the project budget.
- Have proven firm and consultant team experience with Building Information Modeling practices that incorporate survey work into the broader context of object oriented data management.
- Have demonstrated firm and consultant team capability to respond creatively and sensitively to an existing facility and an existing campus context.

 - summarize qualifications most relevant to this project
- 2. <u>RELEVANT</u> QUALIFICATIONS (maximum of 2 single-sided or one double-sided page)
 - provide in summary format only
 - do not include general information
 - offer short, focused paragraphs by topic (i.e., building type; technical aspects; etc.)
- 3. <u>RELEVANT</u> PROJECT EXPERIENCE (maximum of 4 single-sided or 2 double-sided pages)
 - Briefly state relevance for each project
 - Specify role of the firm or individual if work was not exclusively by the firm (i.e., joint venture, association); if work was done by individuals on the project team while with other firms, this must be clearly stated
 - Provide a list of the following for each project:
 - project name and location
 - beginning and ending dates of project (including construction)
 - square footage/acreage
 - main project elements
 - owner name with name of contact person

Note: Projects that are currently in design or under construction are acceptable, but completed projects may carry more weight in the evaluation.
