#### SCOPE OF SERVICES

The University of California, Merced is seeking qualified special inspection and testing firms to be part of a qualified pool for as needed minor capital and other various University projects. The University will select and rotate through firms to provide special inspection and testing as needed by the University. The applicable pool will be available for use for 1 year.

The scope of services to be provided shall comply with the California Code of Regulations and all other related applicable codes and standards. Inspections and testing as required by the University includes but not limited to:

- Structural test and special inspections
- Soils analysis, compaction testing and excavations
- Concrete reinforcement, concrete mix design, concrete placement inspection, concrete sampling and cylinder testing
- Asphalt testing including mix property tests, design and density testing.
- Steel fabrication, structural metal testing, welding and bolt torque testing and inspection
- CASp inspection
- Reporting & Review includes lab test results and inspection reports.

Firm must be available to provide as needed inspection within 2 weeks of notification.

#### QUALIFICATIONS

The University is seeking a qualified special inspection and testing firm with the following experience and qualifications:

- All inspectors shall be certified in the State of California with at least 5 years of experience
- The proposed testing facility/Laboratory of Record(s) must have approval by the DSA Laboratory Evaluation and Acceptance Program and demonstrate that it meets the requirements for supervision of special inspections, quality control and records retention that would enable the laboratory's engineering manager to file a combined verified report.
- Familiarity and demonstrated experience with working with Universities. University of California experience is preferred.

#### JOINT VENTURES/ASSOCIATIONS

By campus policy, proposals for joint or associated ventures will not be considered for this project.

The University is seeking a creative and talented artist or sculpture studio. The Screening and Selection Committees will be interested in teams that:

- All proposed inspectors and technicians shall be certified in the State of California with at least 5 years of experience.
- Have proven experience in delivering their contracted scope within the contract fee and schedule.
- Have experience working with multiple stakeholders.
- Have experience with a strong customer service culture in project delivery.
- Familiarity and demonstrated experience with working with Universities. University of California experience is preferred.
